Size 20 tatting thread is recommended for a butterfly approx. 2" X 1 1/2".

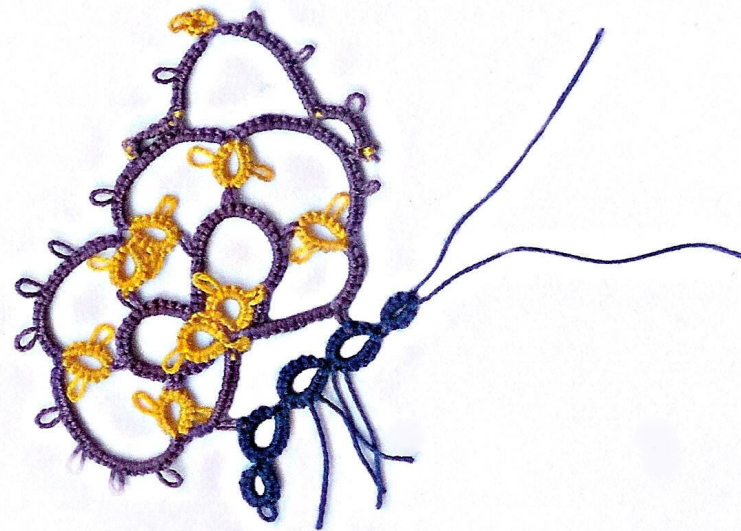
Size 80 tatting thread makes a butterfly approx. 1 1/2" X 1"

- R 6-3-3 cl
- R 3 + (to prev R) 3-3-3 cl RW
- Ch 4 + (to last p of prev R) 6-6-6-6 + (to middle join of double R)
- Ch 6-6-6-6 + (to start) RW
- Ch 10 p 2 RW
- R 3-3 + (to first free p on ch) 3-3 cl RW
- Ch 4-4-4-4-4 RW
- R 3-3 + (to next free p on ch) 3-3 cl RW
- Ch 4-4-4-4 RW
- R 3-3 + (to next p on ch) 3-3 cl
- R 3 + (to p on prev R) 3 + (to next p on ch) 3-3 cl RW
- Ch 4-4-4-4 RW
- R 3-3 + (to next free p on ch) 3-3 cl RW
- Ch 8-4-4-4 RW
- R 3-3 + (to next free p on ch) 3-3 cl RW
- Ch 8-10 + (to start)
- Cut and tie + shuttle and ball thread to arrow on diagram
- Ch 3 + (to next p) 4-4 **Do NOT RW**
- Small R 3-3 cl **Do NOT RW**
- Ch 4-4-4 + (to next p on ch) 3-3 + (to next p on ch)
- Cut and tie off and hide ends
