Academic Scholarship – Xtreme Week – LCCC

Applications will be judged based only on church, school and community activities as well as the submitted essay.

Three \$250.00 academic scholarships are available and useable at any regionally accredited college, university or vocational school. All scholarship funds must be used within 4 years of high school graduation or special arrangements must be made with the board (i.e. military service, mission service, etc). Scholarship awards will be mailed directly to the winners at the address listed on the application.
