

Pitching, Catching, and Fielding:

8.01 Balls must be pitched by hand. There are no restrictions on pitching style.
8.02 Proper Field Position must be maintained by all fielders while a pitch is in progress, and until the pitched ball reaches the

kicker. Failure to be properly positioned will result in a Position Warning to the team that caused the infraction. The team's second and each subsequent Position infraction by that team that game will result in the kicker being awarded first base regardless of the outcome of the kick.

week they brought the team together for some pregame tailgating and provided us some tasty Summer Brew, in October. Miller Lite+Vodka+Limeade=Magic.



Dolls and Balls




