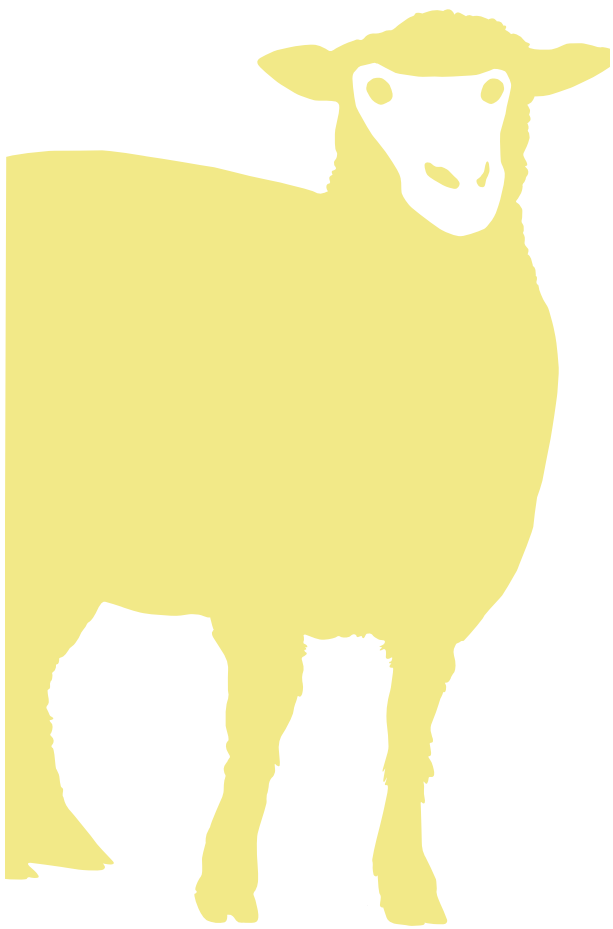


# After School Programs for Scouts at Stone Barns Center

**Stone Barns Center** for Food & Agriculture has programs for Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts ages 5-14. Get your hands dirty working in the greenhouse or get up close and personal with our animals. All of Stone Barns' programs combine fun farm chores and an experience of all the senses that will make for an unforgettable trip.

Programs are held after school on Mondays and Fridays between 3:00 and 5:00 PM. Earlier trips may also be available.

Choose from one of the following programs or work with Stone Barns to create a unique program that applies to your troop's interests or will help fulfill badge requirements.

## 1 HOUR PROGRAMS

*Choose either a plant or animal focus.*

This 1-hour program includes a tour of the farm and a hands-on farm chore. Examples include collecting eggs, planting bulbs or working in the greenhouse.

## 1 1/2 HOUR PROGRAMS

*Focusing on both plants and animals, or a unique program designed for your troop.*

The trip will include a tour of the farm and two hands-on activities: one with the animals and one with plants.

Program fees cover 10 participating children, 2 chaperones and any materials costs. Additional children and adults may join the group at an extra charge. Groups larger than 15 people are booked subject to the availability of an additional tour guide.

\* 1 hour programs are \$150  
(additional children at \$15/child, \$5/adult)

\* 1 1/2 hour programs are \$200
