



## Survival Badge Week 2

**1. Make an emergency shelter and explain what needs to be considered when selecting a site for it.** We built shelters in the woods. - were they big enough for your group? Could you have spent the night in it comfortably? Would it have sheltered you from the rain / wind?

**2. Demonstrate one way of collecting water.** We collected water from a very small stream and tried different ways of purifying it using cloth to filter out sediment, household bleach and puritab tablets. Which methods did your patrol try? Would you have drunk the water in an emergency?

**3. Pack a bag for a day trip to an area unknown to you. This may be an urban or rural location.** Pack a bag for a day trip to a rural / unknown location – what might you need in an emergency? What's in your bag and why? What could you add? What don't you need?

**4. Describe early signs of extreme weather conditions.** How do you know that the weather is changing and that bad weather is coming? What signs are there? See sheet on weather if you need ideas.

**5. a) Recognise three edible and three non-edible plants** (you may use pictures). • Explain how you could use the edible plants in a menu. Last week we collected some edible plants - what did your patrol find / menu ideas?

**5. b) Prepare an emergency kit** - explain what each item is for. Make a kit each, pack it very carefully and understand what each item could be used for.

**6. Know how to use a street map and plan a route to a given location.** Use the Kingsbridge Town map - using the map get girls in your patrol to plan at least 3 of the following routes:

- from Guides to Duncombe Park • from KCC to Kingsbridge Primary School
- from Tourist information to the police station
- from Guides to the leisure centre • from Kingsbridge Primary to Morrisons

**7. Find out about your local transport system, including the times of the last train, bus, Tube or coach to your home.** Bus timetable / bus map – how could you get home from Kingsbridge using the Bus.... is it possible?
