ශ්**ා Scoring**

There are different ways of scoring for archery. **10 zone scoring** is usually used on ranges measured in meters and for bigger targets. **5 zone scoring** for ranges measured in yards. For beginners we can also 'count colours' see the HITS score card on the back of the book...



...and sometimes we might try archery games like bursting balloons pinned to the target.

අා Safety Rules

NEVER point an arrow at anything other than the target! ALWAYS follow the whistle signals.

Whistle signals

• **TWO** whistles means "Archers to the shooting line".

Pick up you bow and stand with one foot either side of the shooting line.

• **ONE** whistle which means "Begin shooting." Pick up an arrow and start shooting.

After you have shot all your arrows, put your bow down and wait.

• **THREE** whistles means it is safe to WALK down to the target line to collect your arrows.



Safety Instructions

The word **FAST** shouted means **STOP** straight away as there is a safety problem.

The words **COME DOWN** mean that just you should stop so that the instructor can help you improve what you are doing.
