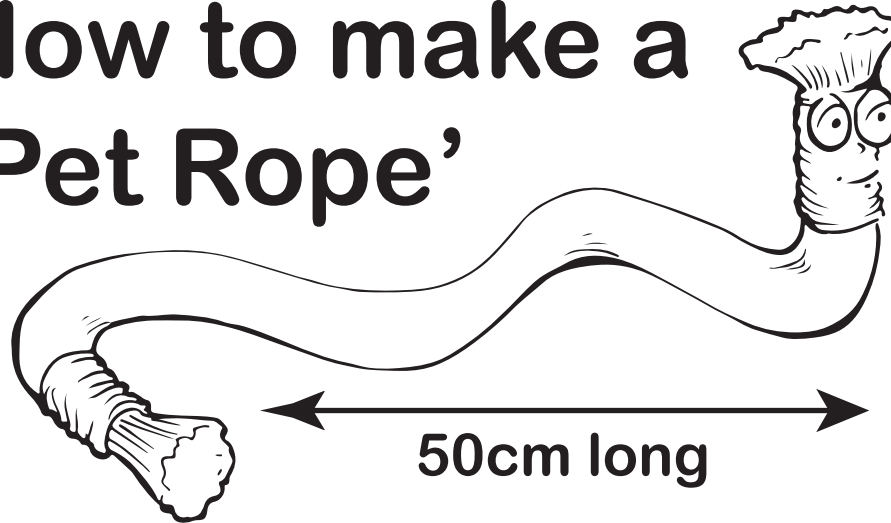




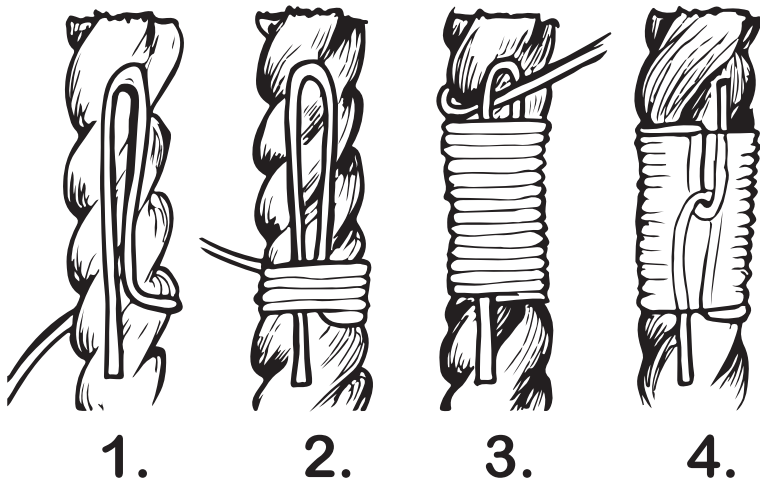
How to make a 'Pet Rope'

To stop the ends of the rope you need to learn to do 'Simple Whipping'. Use the embroidery threads to whip each end of the rope, you could use more than one colour on each end to make a very stylish rope!

Simple Whipping



Glue on the googly eyes using quick drying glue like bostik.

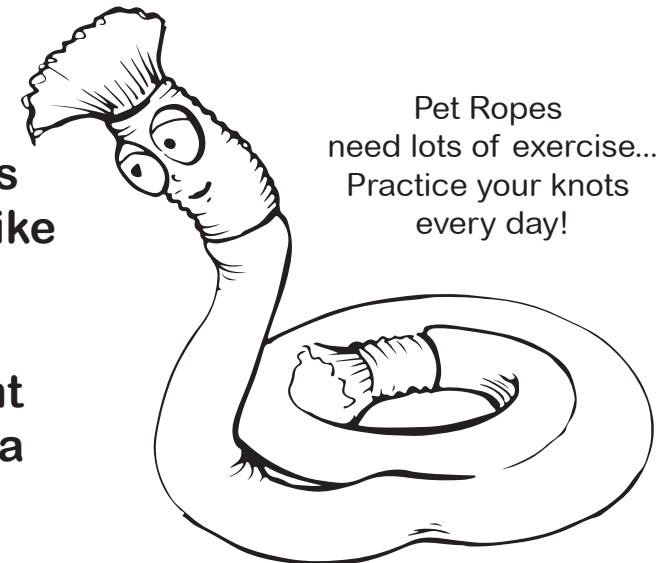
If you have a permanent pen you could draw on a little mouth as well.

A 'Pet Rope' is a practice rope for learning your knots.... it's just a bit of fun really.

To make a pet rope you will need:

- A piece of rope approx 10mm in diameter and 50cm long. Cotton 'Sash cord' which you can buy at hardware shops or on line is nice and soft, or you could use traditional washing line rope... or whatever you can find BUT It's better to use natural ropes rather than synthetic / plastic types though.
- Some coloured embroidery threads or similar coloured thin string
 - Two small googly eyes 3mm size.
 - Clear quick drying glue like 'bostik'
