- Some thin cotton thread to create a hanging loop.

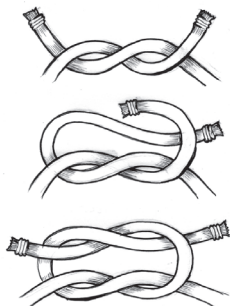
Print out this sheet onto thin card any colour.

Remove the CD holder insert from the CD case.

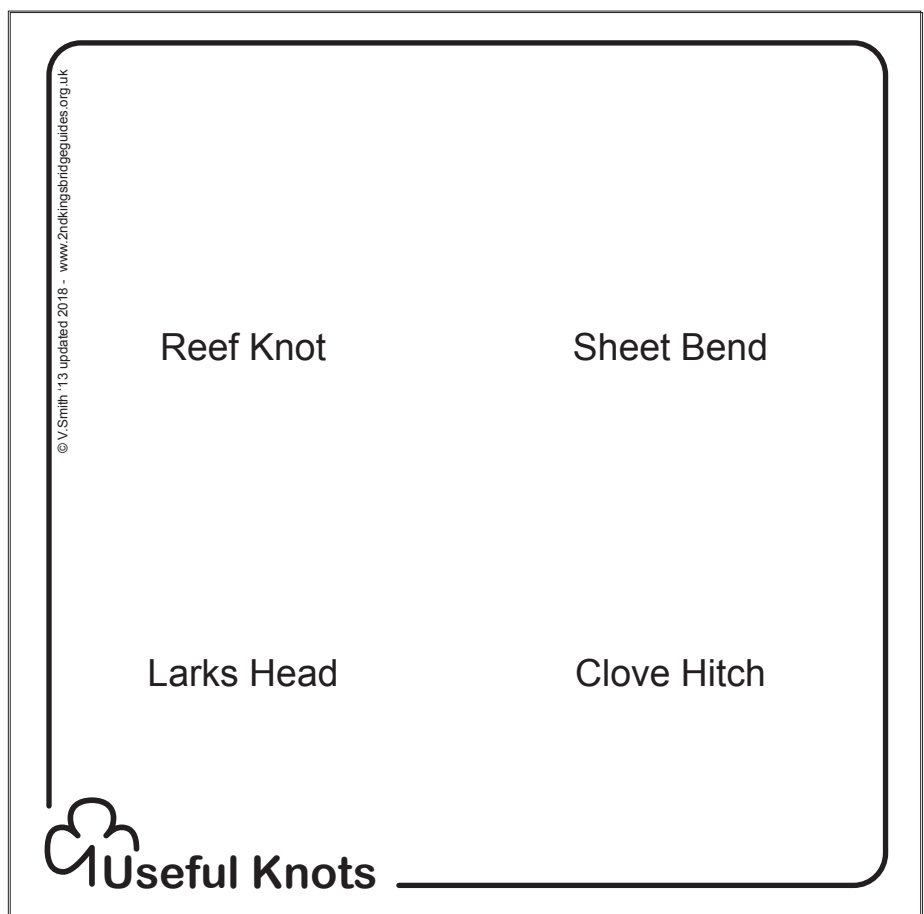
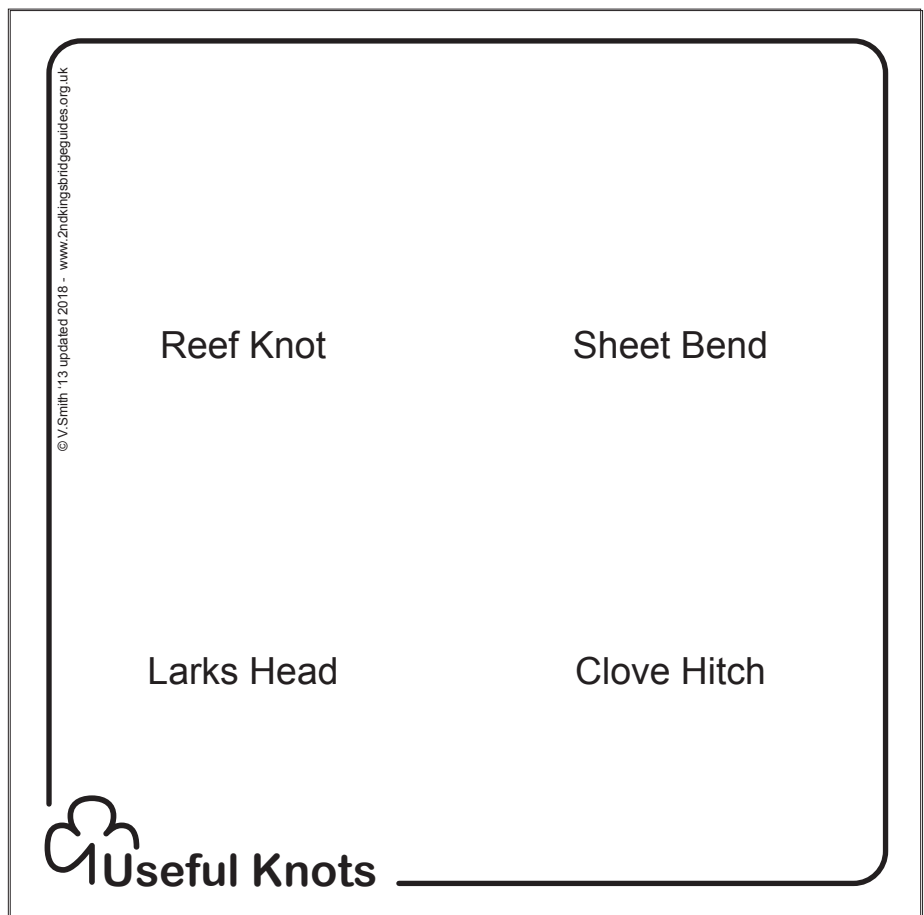
Cut out this square and fit it into a CD case.

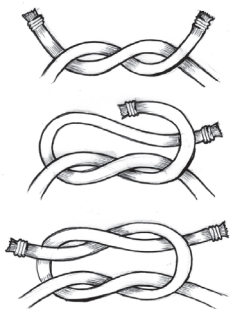

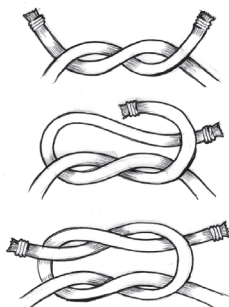
