



- Use an old lampshade frame.
- Add extra 'framework' using kebab sticks and masking tape.
- Add a lamp fitting.  
(cover the lamp fitting a little plastic bag whilst glueing.)



Use coloured tissue and PVA thinned with water to build up the fire colour.



- Build up layers of tissue in 'flame' colours, darker at the bottom, lighter at the top.
- When the tissue is very dry use thick PVA wood glue to attach sticks to the fire, use LOTS of glue. Use secateurs or a saw to trim the wood if needed.
- Use a low voltage bulb to keep the fire from getting too hot!

#### You will need:

- an old lampshade frame
- lamp fitting
- lots of thin dry sticks
- kebab sticks
- masking tape
- 'fire coloured' tissue paper
- PVA wood glue
- lots of newspaper or plastic bags to protect work area
- a sponge and glue mixing bowl
- secateurs
- saw
- small plastic bag to protect lamp fitting.
