

- Use an old lampshade frame.
- Add extra 'framework' using kebab sticks and masking tape.
- Add a lamp fitting.
 (cover the lamp fitting a little plastic bag whilst glueing.)







• Build up layers of tissue in 'flame' colours, darker at the bottom, lighter at the top.

• When the tissue is very dry use thick PVA wood glue to attach sticks to the fire, use LOTS of glue. Use secateurs or a saw to trim the wood if needed.

• Use a low voltage bulb to keep the fire from getting too hot!

You will need:

- an old lampshade frame
 lamp fitting
 lots of thin dry sticks
- kebab sticks masking tape 'fire coloured' tissue paper
- PVA wood glue lots of newspaper or platic bags to protect work area a sponge and glue mixing bowl scissors
- secateurs or saw small plastic bag to protect lamp fitting.
