



Gripping War Story *Fallen Angels*, Walter Dean Myers.

A Harlem teenager joins the Army to fight in the Vietnam War after his dream of going to college falls through.




Beautiful Characters and Imagery *The Bean Trees*, Barbara Kingsolver

A rural Kentucky teen manages to avoid pregnancy in high school, saves up for a car and finally heads west.




Epic American Family Story *A Thousand Acres*, Jane Smiley

A successful Iowa farmer leaves his farm to his three daughters, leaving out his youngest. King Lear in rural America.




Funny and Harsh *Mexican Whiteboy*, Matt de la Peña.

16-year old Danny leaves his prep school to live with his Dad's Mexican family for the summer. Cut from the baseball team, he spends the summer learning who he is.




For Hunger Games fans *Unwind*, Neal Shusterman

A futuristic society where unwanted teens are harvested for their body parts. Three teens escape and you are on the edge of your seat!




Funny, moving and thoughtful *The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian*, Sherman Alexie

A 14 year old transfers from the reservation school to all-white one. He is seen as a traitor, especially when he must confront his old school's team, and his best friend, on the basketball court.




Great Storyteller *A Thousand Splendid Suns*, Khaled Hosseini

The story of two women from different generations reveals the history of Afghanistan from the Soviet invasion to the rise of the Taliban.




Breathaking, tangled tale *The Madonnas of Echo Park*, Brando Skyhorse

A random shooting of a young girl is seen through the different perspectives of the people who live in this LA neighborhood.




Thrilling Nail Biter *The Confession*, John Grisham

For every innocent man sent to prison, there is a guilty one left on the outside. Will the real killer confess after the football player is accused of killing the cheerleader?




Unforgettable Story *The Book Thief*, Markus Zusak


Cannot put this one down! *Imani in Young Love and Deception*, Jackie Hardrick

Imani plays basketball and is on her way to college. She meets a boy but tries to stay true to her goals.




How to Survive Prep School *Prep*, Curtis Sittenfeld

A midwestern girl wins a scholarship to a New England prep school and tries to find her place in this alien world. For mature readers.




Bone-chilling! *Into Thin Air*, Jon Krakauer

A climbing disaster on Mt Everest left 5 men dead. Krakauer was among the survivors and tries to figure out what went wrong with the climb.




Terrifying and True *The Hot Zone*, Richard Preston

A secret military SWAT team of soldiers and scientists mobilizes to stop the outbreak of a deadly virus in this terrifyingly true story.




Fascinating psychology *Blink*, Martin Gladwell
